PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1935.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in November are based on returns from the 31 companies whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items classified as "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production.- The total output of all items of concentrated milk combined, was 5,795,602 pounds, a decrease from the preceding month of 2,427,025 pounds, or 30 per cent, but an increase over November, 1934, of 83,800 pounds, or 1 per cent. The principal item of production is evaporated milk, its total poundage representing 60 per cent of the combined output of all items. Both evaporated milk and condensed milk show increases over November, 1934, but skim milk powder, which is second in importance with regard to quantity of output, records a decrease.

Cumulative Production.- Total output for the 11 months ended November, 1935, amounted to 99,570,173 pounds, an increase over the corresponding period of 1934 of 10,577,631 pounds, or 12 per cent.

Foreign Trade.- The export of every item was less than in November, 1934 - evaporated milk decreased by 28 per cent, condensed milk by 14 per cent, and milk powder by 18 per cent. The imports of concentrated milk are of comparatively little importance. The principal item of import in November was casein, with a total of 25,831 pounds, compared with 496 pounds in November, 1934.

Storage Holdings.- The amounts in storage at date of December 1 were considerably less than at date of November 1, but were larger for most of the items than at date of December 1, 1934. Evaporated milk shows an increase over December 1, 1934, of 25 per cent and skim milk powder an increase of 64 per cent.
