CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTION, CANADA, AUGUST, 1935.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in August are based on returns from the 31 companies whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items classified as "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production. The combined production of all kinds of concentrated milk in August, 1935, was 10,538,753 pounds, compared with 11,558,542 pounds in the preceding month and 9,622,441 pounds in August, 1934. Evaporated milk and skim milk powder continue to show increases over 1934 and a slight increase is recorded for condensed milk.


Cumulative Production. The combined production of the various items in the eight months ended August 31, 1935, was 75,894,008 pounds, an increase over the corresponding period of 1934 of 10,224,310 pounds, or 16 per cent. There was an increase of 21 per cent in the production of evaporated milk, of 16 per cent in the output of skim milk powder, and an increase of 8 per cent in the production of condensed milk.

Foreign Trade. - Evaporated milk shows an increase in quantity exported, compared with a year ago, but the exports of condensed milk and milk powder were less. Total exports for the three items combined was 3,263,100 pounds, compared with 2,833,500 pounds in August, 1934. The importation of concentrated milk was small, the several items combined totalling only 3,509 pounds.

Storage Holdings. - Amounts held in cold storage warehouses were, as a whole, larger at date of September 1, 1935, than at the same date in 1934. Evaporated milk, the principal item, shows an increase of over a million pounds, but a decrease is noted for cream powder.
