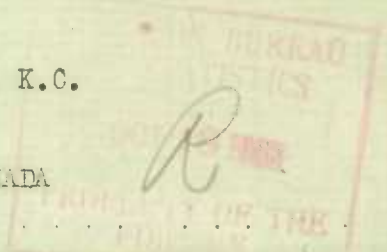

CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTION, CANADA, SEPTEMBER, 1935

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in September are based on returns from the 31 companies whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items classified as "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production.- From February to August of the present year each month has shown an increase over the corresponding month of 1934 in the total output of concentrated milk, and September continues this record. The combined production of all items in September was 9,657,936 pounds, an increase over September, 1934, of 785,012 pounds, or 9 per cent. Contributing chiefly to the increase are the items, evaporated milk and skim milk powder.

Cumulative Production.- The total output of all items for the nine months ended September 30, 1935, was 85,551,944 pounds, compared with 74,542,622 pounds in the corresponding period of 1934. Evaporated milk shows an increase over 1934 of 9,016,700 pounds, or 20 per cent, and skim milk powder an increase of 2,349,830 pounds or 18 per cent. A decrease is shown in the production of condensed milk.

Foreign Trade.- The principal item of export is evaporated milk with a total in September of 1,908,500 pounds. This is a decrease from September, 1934 of 752,200 pounds. The other items in the month under review were condensed milk (191,300 lb.) and milk powder (234,500 lb.). Import figures for September are not available at the present date.

Storage Holdings. Stocks of concentrated milk in storage warehouses at date of September 1 were much in excess of those at a similar date in 1934, for all items excepting the minor ones of cream powder and casein. The quantity of evaporated milk held is greater by 31 per cent and skim milk powder by 96 per cent.
