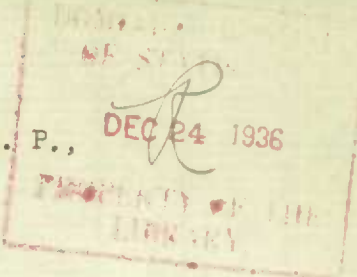

PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1936.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in November, 1936, are based on returns from the thirty-five firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items included in the classification "concentrated milk", viz., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, and other.

Production. - The total production of concentrated milk (combining all items) in the month of November was 6,402,531 pounds, a decrease from the preceding month of 3,142,377 pounds, or 33 per cent, but an increase over November, 1935, of 606,929 pounds, or 10 per cent. November of the present year establishes a high record for that month in the period 1931 to 1936.

Cumulative Production. - For the eleven months ended November 30, 1936, the total production of all items combined was 101,665,239 pounds, compared with 99,570,173 pounds in the corresponding period of 1935. Production to the end of November in the present year is greater than for any similar period since the year 1930, when the cumulative production for the 11 months reached a total of 105 million pounds.

Foreign Trade. - The quantities of concentrated milk exported in November were less for all items excepting casein than in November 1935. The total of all items exported was 1,401,800 pounds, compared with 2,493,800 pounds in November of last year. The import figures for November are not yet available.

Storage Holdings. - Amounts held in storage at date of December 1 were less for most items than at the corresponding date in 1935, the exceptions being condensed milk, evaporated skim milk and buttermilk powder, which recorded increased holdings. The combined total for all items was 12,214,440 pounds, compared with 14,755,952 pounds at December 1st, 1935.
