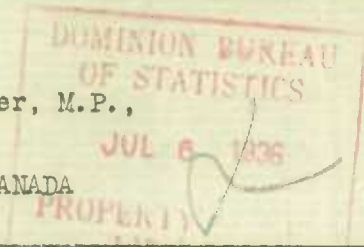

PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, MAY, 1936

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in May, 1936, are based on returns from the 34 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items included in the classification "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, or other.

Production.- The combined production of all items during the month of May was 12,030,910 pounds, an increase over the preceding month of 3,153,629 pounds, or 36 per cent, and an increase over May, 1935, of 89,136 pounds, or 1 per cent. The increase over May, 1935, is due chiefly to the gains made by condensed milk and milk powder.

Cumulative Production.- The combined total of all items manufactured during the 5 months ended May 31, 1935, was 37,786,866 pounds, compared with a total of 39,739,657 pounds in the corresponding period of 1935.

Foreign Trade.- Export increased over April, but records a considerable decrease compared with May, 1935. The combined total for all items of export was 1,556,400 pounds, compared with 3,007,600 pounds in May, 1935. Import figures are not available at date of the issue of this report.

Storage Holdings.- Concentrated milk held in storage at date of June 1, 1936, was on the whole less than the quantity held at the same date in 1935. Decreases are recorded for all items excepting cream powder.
