PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, JULY, 1936.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in July, 1936, are based on returns from the 36 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, or other.

Production.- The production of concentrated milk in July, combining all items, totalled 12,296,410 pounds, a decrease from the preceding month of 1,691,106 pounds, or 12 per cent, but an increase over July, 1935, of 737,863 pounds, or 6 per cent. The principal item - evaporated milk - had a production more than a million pounds greater than in July of last year, but decreases are recorded for condensed milk and skim milk powder, the two items next in importance.

Cumulative Production.- The production of all items, combined, for the 7 months ended July 31, 1936 was 64,070,792 pounds, compared with 65,355,255 pounds in the corresponding period of 1935. The three principal items, viz., evaporated milk, condensed milk and skim milk powder, record decreases from 1935.

Foreign Trade. - The total export was greater than in the preceding month, but less than in July, 1935. Compared with July of last year the export of evaporated milk shows a decrease of 7 per cent, of milk powder a decrease of 22 per cent and of condensed milk a decrease of 54 per cent. The import figures are not available at date of the issue of this report, but the imports in any one month are of comparatively little importance.

Storage Holdings. - The total of the different items held in storage at date of August 1 was 11,584,035 pounds, compared with a total of 14,046,613 lbs. at July 1 and 17,121,558 pounds at August 1, 1935. Evaporated milk and skim milk powder show decreases of 26 per cent and 55 per cent respectively, compared with August 1 of last year.
