PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, AUGUST, 1936.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in August, 1936, are based on returns from the 35 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification "concentrated milk", i.g., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, or other.

Production.— The combined production of all items of concentrated milk in August 1936 was 11,047,501 pounds compared with 12,296,410 pounds in the preceding month and 10,538,753 pounds in August 1935. Inc. and from a year ago are recorded for nearly all items - the exceptions being whole milk powder, skin milk powder and buttermilk powder, which show decreased production.

Cumulative Production. - The total production of all items combined, in the eight months ended August 31, 1936, was 75,118,293 pounds, a decrease over the corresponding period of 1935 of 775,715 pounds or 1 per cent.

Foreign Trade. - Evaporated milk and condensed malk whow decreases in quantity exported, compared with a year ago, but the exports of milk powder were more. Total exports for the three items combined was 3,151,400 pounds compared with 3,263,100 pounds in August 1935. The import figures for August are not available at the present date.

Storage Holdings. The amounts held in cold storage warehouses at date of September 1, 1936, were less than the holdings at the same date in 1935. Evaporated milk, the principal item, shows a decrease of over a million pounds.
