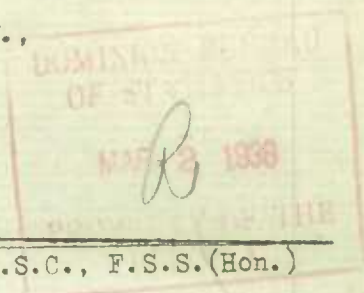

Revised Statement of the Production of Concentrated milk, Canada, December, 1937.

Since the issue on January 20th of the report on the production of concentrated milk, December, 1937, errors have been found in the monthly statements furnished throughout the year 1937 by two firms. These errors concern the production of evaporated milk. It has been decided, therefore, to re issue the December Monthly and give the revised figures. Tables 1, 2 and 3 are affected.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in December, 1937, are based on returns from the 40 firms whose factories manufactured during the month, any of the various items comprised in the classification "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production.- The combined total for all items of concentrated milk in December amounted to 8,205,525 pounds, an increase over December, 1936, of 1,370,284 pounds, or 20 per cent.

Cumulative Production.- The production of all items combined, in the calendar year 1937 was 137,831,601 pounds, compared with 108,500,480 pounds in the year 1936.

Foreign Trade.- The exportation of concentrated milk in December was two and one-half times as great as in December, 1936. Increases are recorded for all items, the increase in the export of evaporated milk amounting to 147 per cent, of condensed milk to 437 per cent, and of milk powder to 12 per cent.

Storage Holdings.- Stocks in storage warehouses were less at date of January 1, 1938, than at a similar date in 1937. Decreases are recorded for all items excepting condensed milk, buttermilk powder and casein.
