## PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, AUGUST, 1937

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in August, 1937, are based on returns from the 41 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production. - The combined production of all items of concentrated milk in August amounted to 15,938,695 pounds, a decrease from the preceding month of 1,104,321 pounds, or 6 per cent, but an increase over August, 1936, of 4,891,194 pounds, or 44 per cent. Production in every year is highest in June, and after that month there is a gradual reduction in output, extending through the fall and winter months.

Cumulative Production. - All items combined show, for the eight months ended August 31, a total output of 102,098,386 pounds, compared with 75,118,293 pounds in the corresponding period of 1936. The increase in the manufacture of evaporated milk is especially noticeable.

Foreign Trade. - The exports of concentrated milk in August were alightly higher than in August of the preceding year, all items registering increases. Import figures for August of the present year are not available at date of the preparation of this report.

Storage Holdings. An amount of 18,329.485 pounds is shown as the total for all items of concentrated milk held in storage warehouses at date of September 1. This figure compares with a total of 17.393,408 pounds at August 1, and 16,710,022 pounds at September 1, 1936. The principal items are evaporated milk and skim milk powder.
