PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, DECEMBER, 1938.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in December, 1938, are based on returns from the 51 firms whose factories manufactured during the month, any of the various items embraced in the classification "concentrated milk", 1.e., condensed milk. evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production. - The total quantity of all items of concentrated milk manufactured during the month of December was 8,450,446 pounds, a decrease from the preceding month of 31,059 pounds, but an increase over December, 1937, of 244,921 pounds.

Cumulative Production . - The production of concentrated milk in the calendar year 1938 amounted to 161,086,445 pounds, compared with 137,831,601 pounds in the year 1937. The principal item is evaporated milk with a production of 105,592,450 pounds, compared with 91,054,153 pounds in 1937. Skim milk powder is second in order of quantity of product and condensed milk third.

Foreign Trade. - Total exports of concentrated milk were considerably lower than in December, 1937. Evaporated milk decreased by 65 per cent, milk powder by 24 per cent and condensed milk by 71 per cent.

Storage Holdings. - The total amount held in storage at date of January 1st, was 24,575,451 pounds, compared with 26,880,117 pounds at the beginning of the preceding month. Decreases are recorded in the stocks of evaporated milk and skim milk powder, while an increased quantity is shown for condensed milk.
