PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1938.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in February, 1938, are based on returns from the 49 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items included in the classification "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production. - The combined production of the several items of concentrated milk in February, 1938, was 7,973,569 pounds, compared with 6,306,948 pounds in February, 1937.

The following tables contain statistics of production, imports and exports and storage holdings.
