PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, MAY, 1938.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in May, 1938, are based on returns from the 52 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items included in the classification "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production. - The production of all items of concentrated milk, combined, in the month of May amounted to 19,638,875 pounds, an increase over the preceding month of 4,303,165 pounds or 28 per cent, and an increase over May, 1937 of 5,659,211 pounds, or 40 per cent. The large increase over May of last year is attributable chiefly to the item evaporated milk, the production of which rose from 9,030,465 pounds to 13,245,192 pounds.

Cumulative Production. - For the five months ending May 31, 1938, the total production of all items was 63,690,311 pounds compared with 47,205,120 pounds in the corresponding period of 1937.

Foreign Trade. - The exports of evaporated milk and milk powder were greater than in May, 1937, but the export of condensed milk shows a decrease. The import figures for concentrated milk are not available at date of the preparation of this report.

Concentrated Milk in Storage. - The holdings of concentrated milk at date of June 1, totalled, for all items, 19,424,263 pounds, an increase over the preceding month of 5,740,859 pounds or 42 per cent.
