PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, OCTOBER, 1939.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in October, 1939, are based on returns from the 60 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.


Production. The combined production of items included in the classification of "concentrated whole milk products" amounted to 13,043,794 pounds, an increase over the preceding month of 737,701 pounds, or 6 per cent, and an increase over October, 1938, of 4,805,972 pounds, or 58 per cent. Evaporated milk is the principal item, and its production of 11,309,960 pounds shows an increase over October, 1938, of 63 per cent. Concentrated milk by-products record a total output of 2,585,446 pounds, a decrease from the preceding month of 573,493 pounds, or 18 per cent, and a decrease from October, 1938, of 613,112 pounds, or 19 per cent. Together, the concentrated milk and milk by-products reached a total of 15,629,240 pounds, an increase over October, 1938, of 4,192,862 pounds, or 37 per cent.

<u>Cumulative Production</u>.- The concentrated milk produced during the ten months ended October 31 of the present year was 112,473,456 pounds, and the concentrated milk byproducts, 30,739,612 pounds, or a total of 143,213,068 pounds, compared with a total of 144,154,494 pounds in the corresponding period of 1938.
