PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1946.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in November, 1940, are based on returns from the 58 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.

Production. - The quantity of concentrated milk manufactured in November amounted to 11,874,242 pounds, a decrease from the preceding month of 2,999,171 pounds, or 20 per cent, and a decrease from November, 1939, of 202,515 pounds, or 2 per cent. The total manufacture comprises 9,800,863 pounds classified as concentrated whole milk products, and 2,073,379 pounds as by-products.

Cumulative Production. - For the 11 months ended November 30, production amounted to 183,097,654 pounds, compared with 155,289,825 pounds in the corresponding period of 1939.

Foreign trade. - The exports of concentrated milk products in November totalled 6,089,600 pounds, an increase over the preceding month of 1,375,600 pounds, or 21 per cent and an increase over November, 1939, of 1,631,900 pounds, or 37 per cent. Import statistics are not available at date of the preparation of this report.

Stocks. - Storage holdings of concentrated milk at date of December 1 totalled 25,248,431 pounds. compared with 34,330,140 pounds at November 1 and 14,131,467 pounds at December 1, 1939.
