

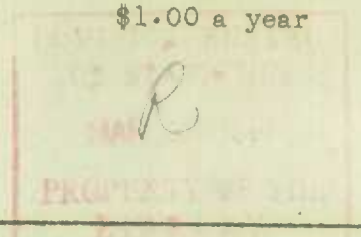

PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1940.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in February, 1940, are based on returns from the 58 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder, skim milk powder, etc.

Production.- The aggregate production of the various items of concentrated milk in February, was 9,270,017 pounds, an increase over February, 1939, of 3,359,876 pounds, or 57 per cent. To the total for February of the present year the concentrated whole milk products contributed 7,321,239 pounds, and the by-products, 1,948,778 pounds. Evaporated whole milk is the principal item of manufacture, its production in February representing 70 per cent of the total for all items. Skim milk powder is second in order of quantity of product, its output representing 14 per cent of the total.
