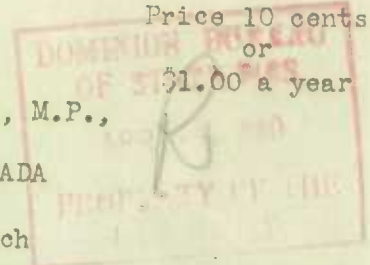

PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, MARCH, 1940

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in March, 1940, are based on returns from the 58 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.

Production.- The production of concentrated whole milk products and by-products in the month of March totalled 12,461,304 pounds, an increase over the preceding month of 3,191,287 pounds, or 34 per cent, and an increase over March, 1939, of 2,825,074 pounds, or 29 per cent.

Cumulative Production.- The production of all items, combined, in the three months ended March 31 was 31,650,676 pounds, compared with 22,728,059 pounds in the corresponding period of 1939.

Exports.- The exports of the various items of concentrated milk in March totalled 2,566,300 pounds, compared with 2,919,900 pounds in March of last year.

Stocks.- The storage holdings of concentrated whole milk and by-products, at date of April 1, amounted to 13,536,750 pounds, compared with 13,540,283 pounds at April 1st, 1939.
