PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, APRIL, 1940

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in April, 1940. are based on returns from the 59 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporate whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.

Production.— The combined production, in April, of all items was 16,845,445 pounds, comprising 13,378,657 pounds of concentrated whole milk products and 3,466,788 pounds of by-products. The total production shows an increase over the preceding month of 4,384,141 pounds, or 35 per cent, and over April, 1939, of 3,541,008 pounds, or 27 per cent.

Cumulative Production. Canada's production of concentrated whole milk and by-products in the four months ended April 30 was 48,496,121 pounds, compared with 36,032,496 pounds in the corresponding period of 1939.

Foreign Trade. The exports of concentrated milk during the month of April aggregated 1,885,200 pounds, compared with 2,420,600 pounds in April, 1939. Import figures are not available at date of the preparation of this report.

Stocks. The total holdings at date of May 1, for all items combined was 16,550,762 pounds, compared with 13,536,750 pounds at the beginning of the preceding month and 14,070,298 pounds at date of May 1, 1939.
