PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED HILK, CANADA, MAY, 1940

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in Nay, 1940, are based on returns from the 59 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.

Production. - The production of concentrated milk in the month of May amounted to 21,159,852 pounds, an increase over the preceding month of 4,314,407 pounds, or 26 per cent, and an increase over May, 1939, of 3,418,217 pounds, or 19 per cent. The amount is divided between the classification of "concentrated whole milk products", totalling 17,006,807 pounds, and that of "concentrated milk by-products", totalling 4,153,045 pounds.


Cumulative Production. - The production of all items of concentrated milk, combined, in the five months ended May 31, amounted to 69,655,973 pounds, compared with 53,774,131 pounds in the corresponding period of 1939.

Foreign Trade. - The exports of concentrated milk in May amounted to 1,518,300/compared with 1,885,200 pounds in April and 4,017,100 ounds in May, 1939. Import figures are not available at date of the preparation of this report.

Stocks. - Storage holdings of concentrated milk products at date of June 1 totalled 16,370,321 pounds, compared with 16,550,762 pounds at May 1 and 17,501,538 pounds at date of June 1, 1939.
