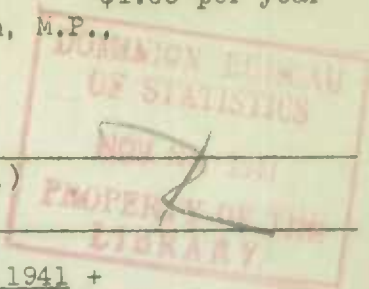

PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, OCTOBER, 1941 +

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in October, 1941, are based on returns from the 59 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.

Production. - Following the seasonal decline normal at this time of the year, the production of concentrated milk (whole milk and by-products combined) dropped to 18,544,770 pounds in October from 22,220,203 pounds in September. The October production, however, records an increase over October, 1940, of 3,661,644 pounds, or 25 per cent.

Cumulative Production. - During the ten months ended October 31 the combined product of all items of concentrated milk was 214,498,313 pounds, compared with 171,279,387 pounds in the corresponding period of 1940.

Foreign Trade. - The quantity of concentrated milk exported in October was 4,984,900 pounds, an amount slightly in excess of export in the preceding month and also of export in October of last year. The import figures for October are not available at date of the preparation of this report.

Stocks. - The storage holdings of concentrated milk (all items combined) at date of November 1 totalled 28,886,024 pounds, compared with 32,859,150 pounds at date of October 1 and 34,321,476 pounds at November 1, 1940.
