PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1941

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in February, 1941, are based on returns from the 56 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.


The combined output of all items of concentrated milk in February was 12,067,340 pounds, a decrease from the preceding month of 499,725 pounds, or 4 per cent, but an increase over February, 1940, of 2,797,323 pounds, or 30 per cent. The total comprises 10,102,161 pounds of concentrated whole milk products and 1,965,179 pounds of by-products.

Foreign Trade. - The exports of concentrated milk in February amounted to 6,310,600 pounds, an increase over the preceding month of 1,435,000 pounds, or 29 per cent, and an increase over February, 1940, of 4,345,800 pounds, or 221 per cent. The principal item is evaporated milk, with a total of 4,330,600 pounds, and second is condensed milk with 1,423,400 pounds. The import figures for February are not available at date of the preparation of this report.

Stocks.- The quantity of concentrated milk held in storage at date of March 1 was 8,670,494 pounds, a reduction from February 1 of 4,060,614 pounds, or 32 per cent, and a decrease from March 1, 1940, of 3,811,353 pounds, or 31 per cent.


