PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, JANUARY, 1942+

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in January, 1942, are based on returns from the 64 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, while milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.

Production - The combined output of all items of concentrated milk and byproducts in January was 11,091,072 pounds, a reduction from the preceding month of
965,383 pounds, or 3 per cent, and a decrease from January, 1941, of 1,475,993 pounds,
or 12 per cent. Each of the three main items, i.e., evaporated whole milk, condensed
whole milk, and skim milk powder, records decreased production as compared with January
of last year.


Foreign Trade. The export of concentrated milk in January shows a total for all items of 4,485,000 pounds, compared with 13,405,200 pounds in December and 4,875,600 pounds in January, 1941. The import figures for January are not available at date of the preparation of this report.

Stocks. The amount of concentrated milk held in storage at date of February 1 was 12,752,887 pounds, compared with 18,717,899 pounds at January 1, and 12,731,108 pounds at February 1, 1941.


