PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1942X

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in November, 1942, are based on returns from the 65 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.

Production .- The combined total of all items of concentrated whole milk and byproducts manufactured during the month of November was 15,432,736 pounds, an increase over November, 1941, of 1,349,461 pounds, or 10 per cent. Evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder each increased its production by 15 per cent, while condensed whole milk decreased by 27 per cent.


Cumulative Production. - The total amount of concentrated whole milk and by-products manufactured during the 11 months ended November 30, was 251,203,756 pounds, compared with 228,581,588 in the corresponding period of 1941.


