PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, APRIL, 1942

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in April, 1942, are based on returns from the 66 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.

Production. - The combined output of all kinds of concentrated milk in April was 23,988,533 pounds, compared with 17,467,311 pounds in March and 22,107,178 pounds in April of last year. The whole milk products account for a total of 20,004,669 pounds, or 83 per cent and the by-products for 3,983,864 pounds, or 17 per cent.

Cumulative Production. - The manufacture of the various items during the four months ended April 30, 1942 amounted to 63,921,043 pounds, compared with 62,626,256 pounds in the corresponding period of 1941 and 48,522,228 pounds in that of 1940.


Foreign Trade. - The exports of concentrated milk in April totalled 2,674,600 pounds, a decrease from the preceding month of 40,100 pounds, and a decrease from April, 1941, of 982,600 pounds. The export of evaporated milk decreased from April, 1941, by 61 per cent, while the export of condensed milk shows an increase of 321 per cent.

Stocks. - The total of the various kinds of concentrated milk held in storage at date of May 1, was 10,719,419 pounds, compared with 9,925,294 pounds at the beginning of the preceding month and 7,414,095 pounds at May 1, 1941. Evaporated milk accounts for 61 per cent of the total.


