PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, JANUARY, 1943(x)

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in January, 1943, are based on returns from the 65 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.

Production. - The total output of concentrated milk (whole milk and by-products) in January amounted to 12,151,134 pounds, compared with 14,059,283 pounds in the preceding month and 11,091,072 pounds in January, 1942. There was less skim milk powder manufactured than in January of last year, but substantial increases are shown for condensed whole milk and evaporated whole milk.
