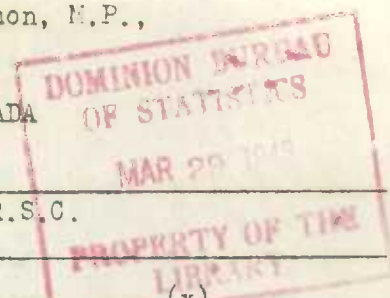

PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1943. (x)

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in February, 1943, are based on returns from the 63 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items embraced in the classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed whole milk and condensed skim milk, evaporated whole milk and evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder, etc.

Production. - The output of concentrated milk (whole milk and by-products, combined) in the month of February amounted to 10,844,099 pounds, compared with 11,374,127 pounds in February, 1942. Decreases are recorded for the three principal items, i.e., condensed and evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder.

Cumulative Production. - For the first two months of the present year the production of concentrated milk (whole milk and by-products) totalled 22,995,233 pounds, compared with 22,465,199 pounds in the corresponding period of 1942.
