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ADVANCE REPORT ON THE FISHERIES OF CANADA 1947

The following report on the fisheries of Canada for the year 1947 is issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, in co-operation with the Dominion Department of Fisheries and the Provincial departments which have jurisdiction over the fisheries of their respective provinces.

PRODUCTION

The value of the Fisheries of Canada reached a new peak in 1947 with a production of \$124,068,909, an increase of \$2,944,176 or 2.4 per cent over the 1946 figure.

This total represents the value of the fish as marketed, fresh, canned, cured or otherwise prepared and includes the value of marine mammals such as belugas and hair seals and of such by-products as oil, meal and seaweed. The sea fisheries contributed \$110,442,897 or 89 per cent and the inland fisheries \$13,626,012 or 11 per cent, to the total.

The salmon fishery retained the leading place, the quantity landed increasing by 9 p.c. The marketed value was \$36,451,170, an increase of \$11,220,837, or 44 per cent, as compared with 1946. It should be observed, however, that part of the increase was due to the canning in 1947 of cold-storage salmon caught in 1946. Other leading species in order of value were: herring, \$17,944,881; cod, \$14,466,881; lobsters, \$10,751,201.

According to marketed value, British Columbia led the other provinces with 47.4 per cent of the total, followed by Nova Scotia with 21.5 per cent; New Brunswick with 13.8 per cent; Ontario with 4.4 per cent; Manitoba with 4.3 per cent; Quebec with 4.3 per cent; Prince Edward Island with 2.3 per cent; Saskatchewan with 0.9 per cent; Alberta with 0.7 per cent; Yukon and the Northwest Territories with 0.4 per cent.

The total quantity of all kinds of fish, including shellfish, taken by Canadian fishermen in 1947 was 12,208,348 cwt., a decrease of 7.4 per cent from 1946. The sea fisheries accounted for 11,412,563 cwt. or 93.5 per cent. Landed quantities and values are shown by provinces in the table that follows:

### CAPITAL

The capital investment in the primary fisheries was \$58,590,500, of which the sea fisheries accounted for \$49,584,946, or 85 p.c. and the inland fisheries for \$9,005,554, or 15 p.c. Statistics of the present value of capital investment in the secondary or processing end of the industry are no longer collected.

### EMPLOYMENT

The fisheries gave employment to 84,050 persons in 1947, although not all of these found year-round employment. The primary operations of catching the fish accounted for 65,419 persons -- 47,249 in the sea fisheries and 18,170 in those of the inland waters -- while the fish-processing end of the industry reported 18,631 persons employed. The primary industry recorded a decrease of 8,095 persons from 1946 and the secondary phase one of 765 persons.
