FIGHERIES OF NOVA SCOTIA, 1922

The following preliminary statement regarding the Fisheries of Nova Scotia for the year 1922, is issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in co-operation with the Department of Marine and Fisheries; The statistics are based on returns furnished by the fishery officers and by the operators of fish canning and curing establishments.

The total value of production of the fisheries of Nova Scotia in 1922, comprising fish marketed for consumption fresh, and canned, cured and otherwise prepared, was \$10,207,444, an increase over the previous year of \$428,821, or four per cent. Cod with \$3,555,727, lobsters with \$2,913,087, mackerel with \$1,129,104, and haddock with \$934,138, together contributed 83 per cent of the total value of production for 1922. The total quantity of all fish caught and landed in 1922 was 2,709,076 cwt., an increase over 1921 of \$12,101 cwt. The value of the fish as caught and landed in a, green state in 1922 was \$7,443,746, an increase over 1921 of \$425,670 or six per cent. Of the chief commercial fishes, increases over the previous year in quantity caught and landed are shown for cod, mackerel, haddock, herming, hake and cusk, salmon and swordfish, and decreases for lobsters, hadibut and pollock.

The tables which follow show (1) the quantity and value of fish caught and landed and marketed, 1921 and 1922; (2) the total values by counties of fish caught and landed and marketed; (3) the total value of production of the fisheries of Nova Scotic for the years 1913 to 1922; and (4) the capital invested in the fisheries and the number of persons employed.

^{4.} Capital and Employees in the Fisherics Industry of Nova Scotia, 1921 and 1922.

(1) Primary Operations:

Capital: The amount of capital represented in the vessels, boats, nets, traps, piers and wharves, etc., engaged in the primary operations of catching and landing the fish, was \$8,764,864 in 1922, compared with \$8,617,961 in 1921.

Employees: The number of men engaged in these operations was 19,495 in 1922 and 19,292 in 1921.

(2) Fish Canning and Curing Establishments:

Capital: The amount of capital represented in fish canning and curing establishments in 1922 was \$3,801,714, compared with \$3,647,504 in 1921.

Employees: The number of persons employed in the establishments was 4,330 in 1922 and 3,946 in 1921.
