PRELIMINARY REPORT OF THE FISHERIES OF NOVA SCOTIA; 1926.

The following preliminary report of the fisheries of Nova Scotia is issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in co-operation with the Department of Marine and Fisheries.

PRODUCTION

A large increase is shown in the fisheries production of Nova Scotia for the year 1926. The total value of the product was \$12,510,885, an increase over the preceding year of \$2,297,106, or 22 per cent, and an increase over the year 1924 of \$3,733,634 or 43 per cent. The value given represents the total value of the fish marketed, whether sold for consumption fresh or canned, cured or otherwise prepared. All of the principal kinds of fish excepting mackerel show increases in quantity caught and all excepting mackerel, hake and cusk and pollock show increases in marketed value. The marketed value of cod was \$4,578,153, an increase over the preceding year of \$817,320 or 22 per cent; of lobsters, \$3,386,416, an increase of \$371,453 or 12 per cent; and of haddock, \$1,671,039, an increase of \$536,712, or 47 per cent. The value of these three kinds together in 1926 represents 77 per cent of the total value of the fisheries production of Nova Scotia in that year. The catch and marketed value of cod, lobsters and haddock are the largest recorded for a number of years.

Statistics of fisheries production are given in detail in table 1, while tables 2 and 3 give totals for a period of years.

CAPITAL EQUIPMENT AND EMPLOYEES

PRIMARY OPERATIONS:

Capital. The amount of capital represented by the steam trawlers, vessels, boats, nets, seines, traps, piers and wharves, etc., used in catching and landing the fish was \$7,979,774; compared with \$7,880,136 in 1925.

Employees. - The number of persons employed in these operations was 16,315, compared with 16,266 in the preceding year.

FISH CANNING AND CURING ESTABLISHMENTS .-

Capital. The total amount of capital invested in the fish canning and curing industry in 1926 was \$4,087,213, an increase over the preceding year of \$292,559. The number of establishments in operation was 246, comprising 132 lobster canneries, 7 clam canneries, 2 miscellaneous fish canneries, 101 fish curing establishments, and 4 plants for the manufacture of fish oil and meal. The number of lobster canneries shows a decrease of 1 compared with the preceding year; and the number of fish curing establishments a decrease of 5. The number of clam canneries increased by 3, while the numbers of miscellaneous fish canneries and reduction works remained the same. The total number of establishments shows a decrease of 3.

Employees. - The persons employed in the establishments in 1926 numbered 3,812, compared with 3,604 in 1925.

Table 4 gives statistics of capital and employees for 1925 and 1926.
