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ADVANCE REPORT ON THE FISHERIES OF NOVA SCOTIA, 1944.

The following report on the fisheries of the province of Nova Scotia, for the year 1944, is issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, in co-operation with the Department of Fisheries.

PRODUCTION

Fisheries production in Nova Scotia, reached a new high point in 1944, the marketed value being \$23,662,055, an increase of \$1,977,620, or 9 p.c. over the 1943 figure. The quantity caught was 3,345,591 cwt., an increase of 350,178 cwt., or 12 p.c., over 1943. The value as landed was \$14,851,376, an increase of \$2,023,611, or 16 p.c. The lower percentage of increase in the total marketed value does not necessarily imply a reduction in the price of processed fish, as quantities of Nova Scotia fish are marketed in adjoining provinces.

Five varieties of fish passed the million-dollar mark in total marketed value; cod, \$10,664,186; lobsters, \$3,759,087; haddock, \$2,156,418; herring, \$1,717,781 and mackerel, \$1,186,754.

CAPITAL EQUIPMENT

The capital investment amounted to \$13,626,934, of which \$7,186,151 or 52.75 p.c. was utilized in the catching and landing of fish and \$6,440,783 or 47.25 p.c. in the fish-processing plants.

EMPLOYMENT

The primary industry employed 13,863 men for varying periods in the year and the secondary, or processing, industry reported 4,093 persons employed. The primary division recorded 493 more men employed than in 1943 while the secondary division reported an increase of 188 persons - 147 males and 41 females.
