#### ADVANCE REPORT ON THE FISHERIES OF NOVA SCOTIA, 1947

The following report on the fisheries of the province of Nova Scotia, for the year 1947, is issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, in co-operation with the Department of Fisheries.

#### PRODUCTION

After passing the thirty-million-dollar mark in 1945 and 1946, the total marketed value of the Nova Scotia fisheries receded to \$26,697,395 in 1947. This decrease of 22 p.c. from the \$34,270,762 recorded for 1946 was due, in large measure, to the strike of deep-sea fishermen in the opening months of the year, but the falling off in the demand for frozen fillets on the United States market was also a very important factor, causing a reduction in prices. Total landings of fish and shell-fish were 3,250,359 cwt, a decrease of 22 p.c. from the 4,176,630 cwt recorded for 1946. Landings of groundfish (cod, haddock, hake, cusk and pollock) fell off by 26 p.c., those of flatfish other than halibut by 11 p.c. and those of lobsters by 11 p.c. The total landed value was \$15,155,593, a decrease of 26 p.c. from the \$20,559,-604 recorded for 1946. Lower prices, as well as smaller quantities, were responsible for the decline.

Only four species passed the million-dollar point in marketed value in 1947, these were: cod, \$9,665,498; lobsters, \$5,535,188; haddock, \$2,424,463 and herring, \$1,818,839.

#### CAPITAL EQUIPMENT

The capital invested in the primary operation of catching and landing the fish amounted to \$12,719,506, an increase of 35 p.c. over the \$9,412,273 reported for 1946. Of the total amount, \$7,600,394 or 60 p.c. was invested in vessels and boats, \$4,285,022 or 34 p.c. in nets and other gear and \$834,090 or 6 p.c. in shore establishments such as piers and wharves, small freezers and smokehouses, etc.

#### EMPLOYMENT

The total number of persons employed in the fisheries of Nova Scotia in 1947 amounted to 18,889, as against 20,829 in 1946. The primary industry reported 14,475 men for varying periods of the year and the secondary, or processing, industry reported 3,084 men and 1,330 women employed. The reduction in the primary industry was 1,385 men and that in the processing end was 555 persons, 376 men and 179 women.
