ADVANCE REPORT ON THE FISHERIES OF NEW BRUNSWICK, 1946

The following report on the fisheries of the province of New Brunswick, for the year 1946, is issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in co-operation with the Department of Fisheries

PRODUCTION

The value of production of the fisheries of New Brunswick in 1946 amounted to \$16,422,201 compared with \$13,270,376 in the preceding year, an increase of \$3,151 325 or 24 p.c. These figures represent the value of the fish as marketed, whether sold for consumption fresh or canned, cured, etc. The lobster fishery recorded marketings of \$4,627,203, a decrease of \$431,498, or 9 p.c., from the \$5,053,701 shown in 1945. The decrease is due to smaller quantities of lobsters being brought in from other provinces for marketing in New Brunswick. The actual New Brunswick catch increased by 20 p.c. over that of 1945. The sardine fishery came second with a marketed value of \$4,169,125 and the herring fishery third with a marketed value of \$2,993,150.

The quantity of fish of all kinds, including shellfish, taken by New Brunswick fishermen during the year totalled 1,268,700 cwt. with a landed value of \$7,145,383 compared with a catch of 1,556,964 cwt. and a landed value of \$5,477,452 in 1945. Average prices received by the fishermen for the three principal kinds of fish were: lobster \$28.34 per cwt. compared with \$25.57 per cwt.; sardines \$3.11 per bbl., compared with \$3.29 bbl., and herring \$1.15 per cwt. compared with \$1.25 cwt. in 1945.

CAPITAL, EQUIPMENT AND EMPLOYEES

The value of the capital investment in the primary industry was \$4,526,695 in 1946 an increase of \$531,017, or 13 p.c. over the \$3,995,678 recorded for 1945.

Employees - The number of men engaged in fishing was 11,074, an increase from 1945 of 306, while the number of persons employed in the fish processing establishments was 4,492, an increase of 727. The total number of persons in the fishing industry in 1945 was 15,566, an increase over 1945 of 1,033.


