

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## ADVANCE REPORT ON THE FISHERIES OF QUEBEC, 1933.

The following report on the fisheries of the province of Quebec, for the year 1933, is issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in co-operation with the Department of Fisheries.

#### PRODUCTION

The total value of the fisheries production of the province of Quebec in 1933 was \$2,128,471, an increase over the preceding year of \$312,927, or 17 per cent, this gain marking the first upward movement since 1928. The total given represents the value of the fish as marketed, whether sold for consumption fresh, or canned, cured and otherwise propared, and covers the sea fisheries (value \$1,601,470) and the inland fisheries (value \$527,001). Of chief importance is the cod fishery, which had an output valued at \$863,913, the principal item being dried cod (value \$626,047). Other important brinds are lobsters, (\$217,476), herring (\$207,415), salmon (\$154,159) and eels (\$131,440). Large increases over the preceding year are shown in the catches of cod, salmon and eels, but decreases are recorded for lobsters and herring.

The total quantity of fish of all kinds (including shell fish) caught during the year was 933,361 cwt., for which the fishermen received a total of \$1,764,211. Compared with the preceding year the catch shows an increase of 13,642 cwt., or 1.5 per cent, and the return to the fishermen an increase of \$312,427, or 21.5 per cent.

#### CAPITAL EQUIPMENT AND EMPLOYEES


Capital.— The amount of capital invested in the fisheries of the province in 1933 was \$2.839,351, divided as follows: vessels, boats, nets, traps, piers and wharves, etc., used in the primary operations of catching and landing the fish, \$2,380,063; and fish canning and curing establishments, \$459,288. Compared with the preceding year the total capital shows an increase of \$14,351.

Employees. - The persons employed in the fisheries included 13,627 fishermen and 939 employees of fish canning and curing establishments, a total of 14,566, compared with 14,691 in 1932. The decrease is in the number of factory employees.

Statistics of the catch, of the product as marketed, and of the capital equipment and employees are given in the following tables.


