## ADVANCE REPORT ON THE FISHERIES OF QUEBEC, 1941.

The following report on the fisheries of quebec for the year 1941 is issued by the Doninion Bureau of Statistics in co-operation with the Dominion Departanent of Fisheries and the Quebec Department of Mines and Fisheries.

## PRODUCTION

Quebec, in conmon with the other provinces of the Atlantic coust, shows a consirlerable increase in 1941 in the value of output of the fisheries. The mariseted Viilue of production of the sea and inland fisheries of the province, combined, was $\$ 2,842,041$, compared with $\$ 2,002,053$ in 1940 . To the total value the sea fisheries contributed $\$ 2,548,702$, an increase over the proceding year of $\$ 346,359$, or 50 per cent, and the inland fisheries, a total of \$233,339, a decrease fror 1940 of $\$ 6,981$, or 2 per cent. Cod is the chief fishory, its marieted value of output in 1041 amounting to $\$ 1,434,162$, or 50 per cent of the total for all kinds. Herring ( $\$ 285,332$ ) and mackerel ( $\$ 257,363$ ) are second and third, respectively, on the list of the chier commercial fishes of the province.

The quantity of fish (sea and inland combined) of all finds, including shell Sish, taken by Quebec fishermen durint the year was $968,520 \mathrm{cw}$., with a vilue to the fishemen of $2,030,432$, compared itith a catch of $1,029,704 \mathrm{cvt}$., and a landod value of $\$ 1,611,250$ in 1340, showing for 1941 compared :ith 1940 , a decrease in quantity of $61,184 \mathrm{cw}$., or 6 per cent, but an increase in landed value of $\$ 469,132$ or 29 per cent.

## CAPITAL ECUIPMENT AND EMPLOYEES

Capital. - The capital investment of the fisheries of the proviace in 1941 had a total value of $\$ 2,854,733$, comprising: $\$ 2,017,662$, the value of the vesisels, boats, nets, piers and wharves, etc. enployed in the primary operations of atchingand landing the fish, and $\$ 837,071$, the amount invested in fish processine establishments. Compared with the preceding year the total investment shows an increase of $\$ 255,400$ or 10 per cent.

Employees. - The number of fishermen employed in 1941 vas 10,614 , a reduction of 2,656 from the preceding year. The fish processing branch of the industry gave employment to 1,120 persons, an increase of 126 . Altogether there were 11,734 persons employed in the fisheries of the province in 1341, compared $\because i t h$ 14, 264 in 1940.
