## FELDSPAR, 1929.

Historical File Copy

Shipments of feldspar by Canadian producers during 1929 increased 17.0. per cent in quantity and 19.5 per cent in value over the totals for 1928, according to finally revised statistics just issued by the mining, metallurgical and chemical branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. The production in 1929 amounted to 27,527 tons valued at \$340,471 as against 31,897 tons worth \$284,942 produced in 1928.

Grude feldspar exported from Canada during 1929 totalled 29,896 tons valued at \$242,915; these exports were principally to the United States. An increase of 24.7 per cent was recorded in the imports of feldspar into Canada in 1929. Importations during the year amounted to 3,955 tons appraised at \$65,997 as against 3,171 tons at \$53,818 in 1928.

The 19 firms in operation during the year reported a total capital investment of \$223,443. Salaried employees and wage-earners engaged in this industry totalled 209 and their combined earnings were \$164,440. Fuel costs for the year amounted to 14;122:
