IELDSPAR, 1929.
Shipments of feldspar by Canadian producers during 1929 -increased 17.0 per cent in quantity and 19.5 per cont in value over the totals for 1928 , according to finally revised statistics just issued by the mining, metallurgical and chemical branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at ottawa. The production in 1929 arnounted to 3\%,52\% what valued at 340,471 as against 31,897 tons worth 3284,942 produced in 1926 . Crude feldspar exported from Canada during 1929 totalled 29,896 toils valued at $\$ 242,915$; these exports were principally to the United States. An increase of 24.7 per cent was recorded in tie imports of feldspar into Canada in 1929. Importations during the year amounted to $z, 955$ tons appraised at 65,997 as against 3,171 ans at "53, 818 in 1928.

The 79 irma in operation during the year reported a total capital investment of 202 and their combined earnings were 164,440 . Fuel costs for the year amounted to 2314; 7.326
