A hew high record for the industry, according to statistics, finally revised. issued by the Mining, Metallurgical and Chemical Bench of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. The 1927 production anointed to 475,591 barrels valued at $\$ 1,516,043$ as compared rich 364,444 barrels worth $\$ 1,311,665$ produced in the previous year.

Alberta's production, mainly from the Turner Valley field, set up a new high mark for the province, reaching a total of 318,741 barrels. Ontario operators reported a slight increase in output, the production for the yean being 139,606 barrels. A large increase was recorded in shipments of oil from New Brunswick wells in 1927 when 18,244 barrels were sold.

Conditions in the oil fields of Ontario shored little chance in 1927. In Alberta 19 Hells were in operation at the close of 1927 and 39 other wells wore in the process of drilling. Drilling operations were conimed during the year in Turner Valley, Wainwright, Ribstone and various other iicias in liberta; the Sa, Creek field, British Columbia, and in Manitoba and Salratehewan.

Petroleum and its products imported into Canada in 1927 were valued at $\$ 52,87 \%, 717$, an increase of $\$ 815,031$ over the 1926 import value of $\$ 52,063,686$. Imports of asphalt and asphaltum oil are not included in the above total: in 2927 these importations increased 117 per cent to a value $0 \leq \$ 965,177$. Gasoline importations rete recorded at $108,258,228$ gallons invoiced $a * \$ 11,418,60 \%$; the Canadian production of refined -asnline as $258,549,24$ gallons and tho exports icanactian and foreign) mere 2,790,672 allows, leaving $363,927,390$ gallons available fou use in canada.
