LEAD, 1930.

Finally revised statistics on the production of lead in Canada during 1930, as reported by the Mining, Metallurgical and Chemical Branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa, show nearly a two per cent increase in quantity over the production of 326,522,566 pounds in 1929. The value, however, was much lower owing to the very depressed prices for the metal.

The metallurgical plant of the Consolidated Mining and Smelting Company at Trail, B.C., treating both customs and Sullivan mine ores, was the greatest contributor to Canada's production of lead; in the same province important shipments of lead concentrates were made to foreign smelters from the Monarch mine at Field.

Pig lead was made in Ontario at the Galetta smelter from Kingdon mine ore and in the Sudbury area the Treadwell Yukon Company continued to produce and ship lead concentrates from the Errington mine.

Lead mining operations in Quebec and Nova Scotia were restricted to very modest development and prospecting programmes, some further exploration was conducted throughout the summer of 1930 on the Great Slave Lake lead occurrences.
