



Natural gas consumption in Medicine Hat totalled 3,072,000 thousand cubic feet in 1930. Some 2,500 industrial and domestic consumers were supplied with gas from the 26 wells in this field. Eight wells in the Redcliff field, 2 miles west of Medicine Hat, supplied gas to industrial and domestic consumers.

The Viking field, located about 80 miles southeast of Edmonton, supplies that city with natural gas. In 1930, over 10,000 consumers in Edmonton used this gas. In addition, approximately 600 users outside of Edmonton are supplied with gas from this field.

The Maple Leaf well supplied gas to 311 consumers in Wainwright during 1930. Local wells supplied Bow Island, Suffield and Wetaskiwin with gas during the year. Lethbridge and some smaller centres were furnished with gas from the Canadian Western Natural Gas Company's pipe line.

Mixed gas (natural and artificial) imported into Canada from the United States amounted to 151,671 thousand cubic feet valued at \$96,763; in 1929 imports totalled 132,942 thousand cubic feet at \$85,338.

Fixed and current assets reported by the 124 firms operating in Canada amounted to \$70,548,353. Employment was furnished 1,941 salaried employees and wage-earners, who received a total remuneration of \$2,349,703. Fuel and electricity used during the year necessitated an expenditure of \$33,811. Primary power employed consisted of 145 units with a manufacturers' rating of 2,745 h.p.
