## ZINC, 1929.

Zinc production in Canada during 1929, as reported in finally revised statistics prepared by the mining, metallurgical and chemical branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, has created a new high record in quantity; the total value is somewhat higher than in 1928. The 1939 production of 197,207,087 pounds, valued at the average London price for the year of 5.387 cents per pound, was worth \$10,626,778. In 1928 the output of 184,647,374 pounds valued at the average London price for the year of 5.4952 cents perpound amounted to \$10,143.050.

Canada's zinc production includes zinc made at Trail, B.C., and the recoverable zinc in ores and concentrates exported; ores treated at the Trail plant of the Consolidated Mining and S elting Company are chiefly those from the Sullivan mine but important tonnages are also received from other mines in the east and west Kootenay districts. Zinc ores and concentrates were exported from the Tetreault silver-leadzinc mine in Quebec, and a considerable amount of zinc was also reported as contained in zinc concentrates antoped from the Errington mine in the Sudbury district, Ontario, to European smallers. During the year intensive development work was done on zinc ore bodies in Cape Breton, northwestern Quebec, and in Manitoba.
