The Value of Consumable Stores and Equipment Purchased and Expenditures for Freight and Insurance, by the Mining and Non-ferrous Metallurgical Industries in Canada, during the Calendar Year 1935.

---

For the second consecutive year, the Mining, Metallurgical and Chemical Branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics has conducted a survey of the expenditures made by the Canadian mining industry for consumable stores, equipment, freight, insurance, etc.

The questionnaire employed in the preceding year for the collection of data was designed in collaboration with the Ontario Mining and Canadian Metal Mining Associations and was retained in its original form for the collection of corresponding statistics in the survey for 1935.

The advisability of increasing the efficiency of the survey to the Canadian manufacturer by enlarging the detail was considered. It was decided, however, that the adoption of the 1934 questionnaire would result in the compilation of definitely comparable statistics that should prove of greater value in any study of present or future consumption trends within the industry as a whole. The decision was also influenced by a hesitation in requesting further details that might prove impractical of recording by operators possessing limited accounting facilities.

The total value of expenditures incurred throughout the entire Canadian mining industry totalled \$84,813,603 in 1935 as compared with \$76,082,765 in the preceding year, representing an increase of 11.5 per cent.

The relative importance in the purchasing power of the various major branches of the industry is revealed in an analysis of the recorded data, also the magnitude of current development programmes is reflected in expenditures in particular spheres of mining. This was especially evident in the totals for the nickel-copper mining, smelting and refining and gold mining industries; the total value of expenditures in the first named

amounted to \$18,135,440 as compared with \$16,170,299 in 1934, while the widespread expansion in the search for and development of gold mines is evidenced in an increase in the value of purchases in this industry from a total of \$23,993,873 in 1934 to \$28,707,183 in 1935.

The total value of expenditures reported by those industries producing fuels, including coal, oil and gas, amounted to \$10,965,363 or an increase of 13.9 per cent over the corresponding total of \$9,626,960 in 1934.

Of a grand total of \$84,813,603 expended by the Canadian mining industry in 1935, Ontario accounted for \$40,974,115 or 48.3 per cent; British Columbia, \$14,464,731 or 17.1 per cent, and Quebec, \$13,100,843 or 15.4 per cent, with the balance being distributed among Nova Scotia, Alberta, Manitoba, Saskatchewan and New Brunswick.

The diversity and magnitude of expenditures by this great Canadian industry, together with its widespread and increasing influence in our industrial life, is better appreciated in a study of the following disbursements for 1935:- freight, \$12,257,410; fuels, \$9,264,217; electric power, \$10,714,600; explosives, \$5,550,217; lumber and timber, \$5,051,087; machinery, \$5,585,301; electrical equipment, \$2,614,265, rock drills and parts, \$1,235,469. A few of the various other items included \$323,444 for safety equipment, \$660,184 for wire rope, \$797,410 for drill and tool steels, \$633,269 for track materials, \$351,503 for belting, \$875,083 for flotation reagents, \$381,929 for rubber goods and \$64,178 for hospital equipment and medical supplies.
