MONTHLY PRODUCTION OF CARBONATED BEVERAGES

April, 1961

Production of Carbonated Beverages in April 1961 was 11,735,438 gallons, a 4.6% increase over the production for the same month in 1960. The cumulative production for the first 4 months of 1961 was 43,136,209 gallons, which is a 3.6% decrease from the 44,767,293 gallons produced in the same period last year.
