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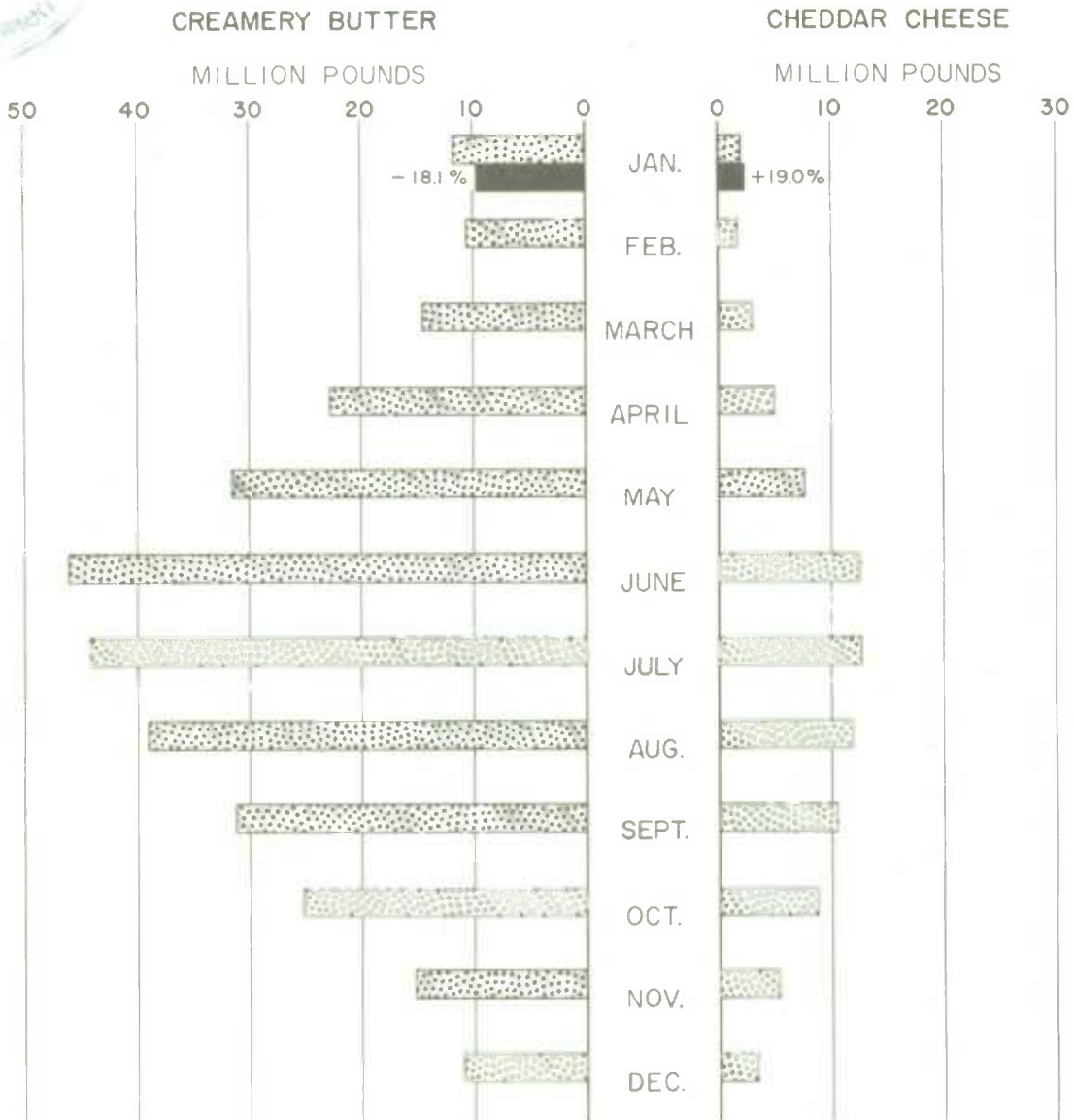

DAIRY FACTORY PRODUCTION

Revised Statistics for 1955 and 1956

In these coloured sheets appended as a supplement to DAIRY FACTORY PRODUCTION for January, 1957, revised statistics are shown for all months, together with yearly production for 1955 and 1956. The present plan of publishing revised statistics for the preceding year commenced with the issue of February, 1950, containing monthly data for 1949. Prior to 1950 revised statistics of Dairy Factory Production as well as other monthly statistics pertaining to dairying, were issued in the form of special reports known as the "Supplement to the Dairy Review". These reports covered the years 1946, 1947 and 1948. For the years 1941 to 1945 revised monthly statistics may be found in the December issue of the Dairy Review, while the January issue of 1937 to 1940 contained similar data for preceding years.

The 1955 factory production figures shown herewith may be regarded as final data. The yearly totals will be used in the Annual Report, DAIRY STATISTICS OF CANADA and other publications of the Bureau in which production figures appear. The 1956 data differ from those published in current issues of DAIRY FACTORY PRODUCTION. These statistics are subject to further revision at the end of 1957 when final and complete figures will be published. The figures shown in these tables, by months, will be used for comparative purposes in current publications issued in 1957. For the convenience of those using these tables a brief synopsis follows:
