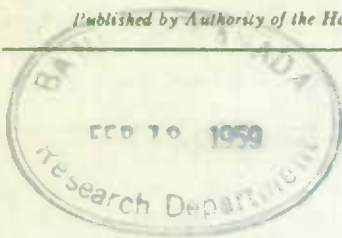

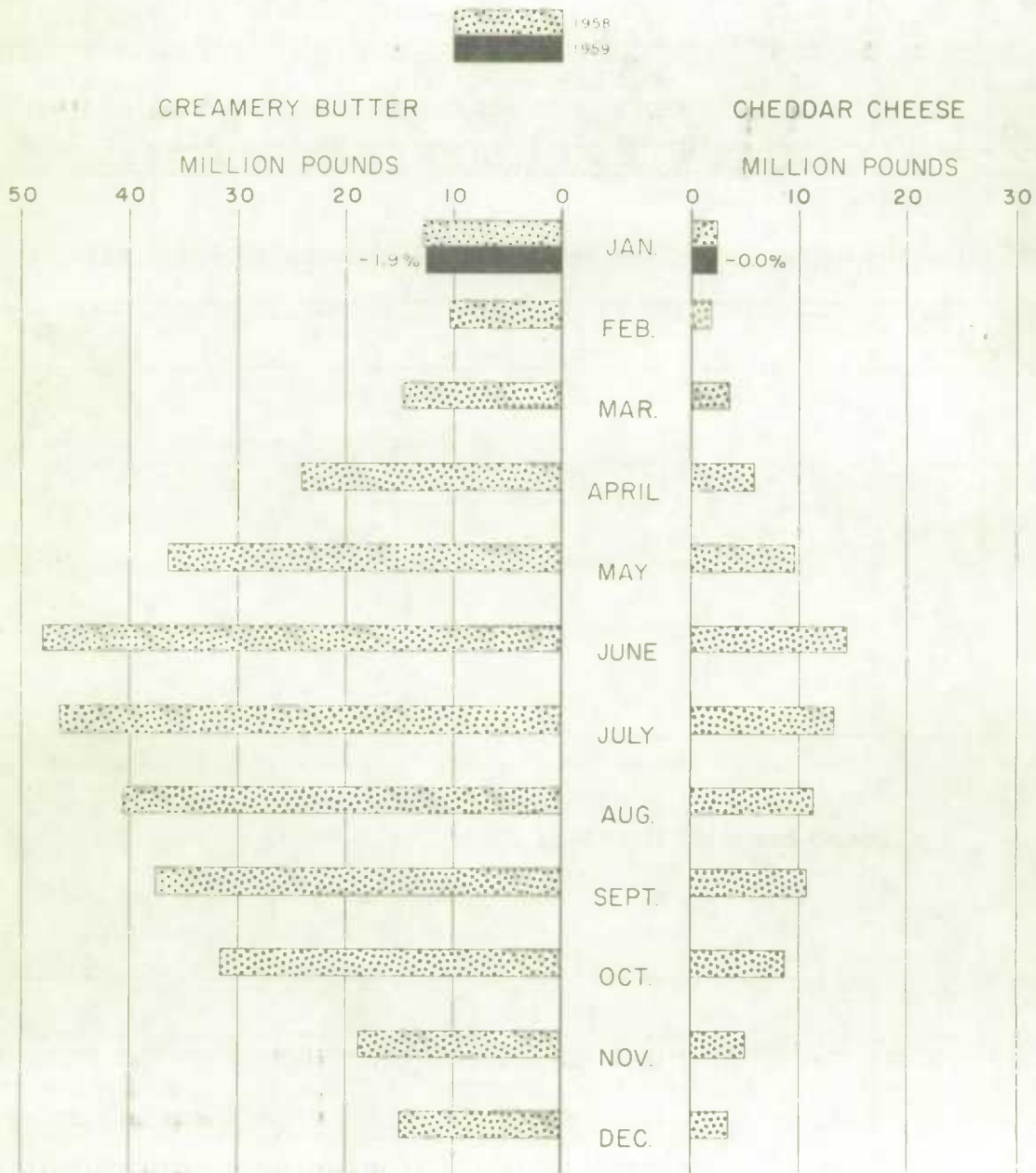

DAIRY FACTORY PRODUCTION

Revised Statistics for 1957 and 1958

In this supplement to DAIRY FACTORY PRODUCTION for January, 1959, revised statistics are shown for all months, together with yearly production for 1957 and 1958. Revised statistics of Dairy Factory Production from 1946 to 1948 were issued each year in special reports entitled "Supplement to the Dairy Review". From 1941 to 1945 they appeared in the December issues of the Dairy Review, while from 1937 to 1940 they appeared in the January issues of the Dairy Review.

The 1957 factory production figures shown herewith may be regarded as final data and the yearly totals will be used in the annual "Dairy Statistics 1958" and other publications of the Bureau in which production figures appear.

Data for 1958, being revised, differ from those published in the monthly issues of "Dairy Factory Production". These statistics are subject to further revision at the end of 1959 when final and complete figures will be published. The figures shown in these tables, by months, will be used for comparative purposes in publications issued in 1959.
