

The Domestic Disappearance of Creamery Butter in Canada during October, according to preliminary production and stock data, amounted to 30,325,000 pounds, 3.9 per cent more than the 29,197,000 pounds in October, 1958. Cumulative January to October disappearance of creamery butter, at 251,319,000 pounds was 2.7 per cent less than the 258,294,000 pounds in the corresponding period of 1958.
