

The Domestic Disappearance of Greamery Butter in Canada during December, according to preliminary production and stock data, amounted to 27,879,000 pounds, almost the same as the 27,903,000 pounds shown for December, 1958. Cumulative January to December disappearance of creamery butter, at 306,566,000 pounds was 2 per cent less than the 312,299,000 pounds in the corresponding period of 1958.
