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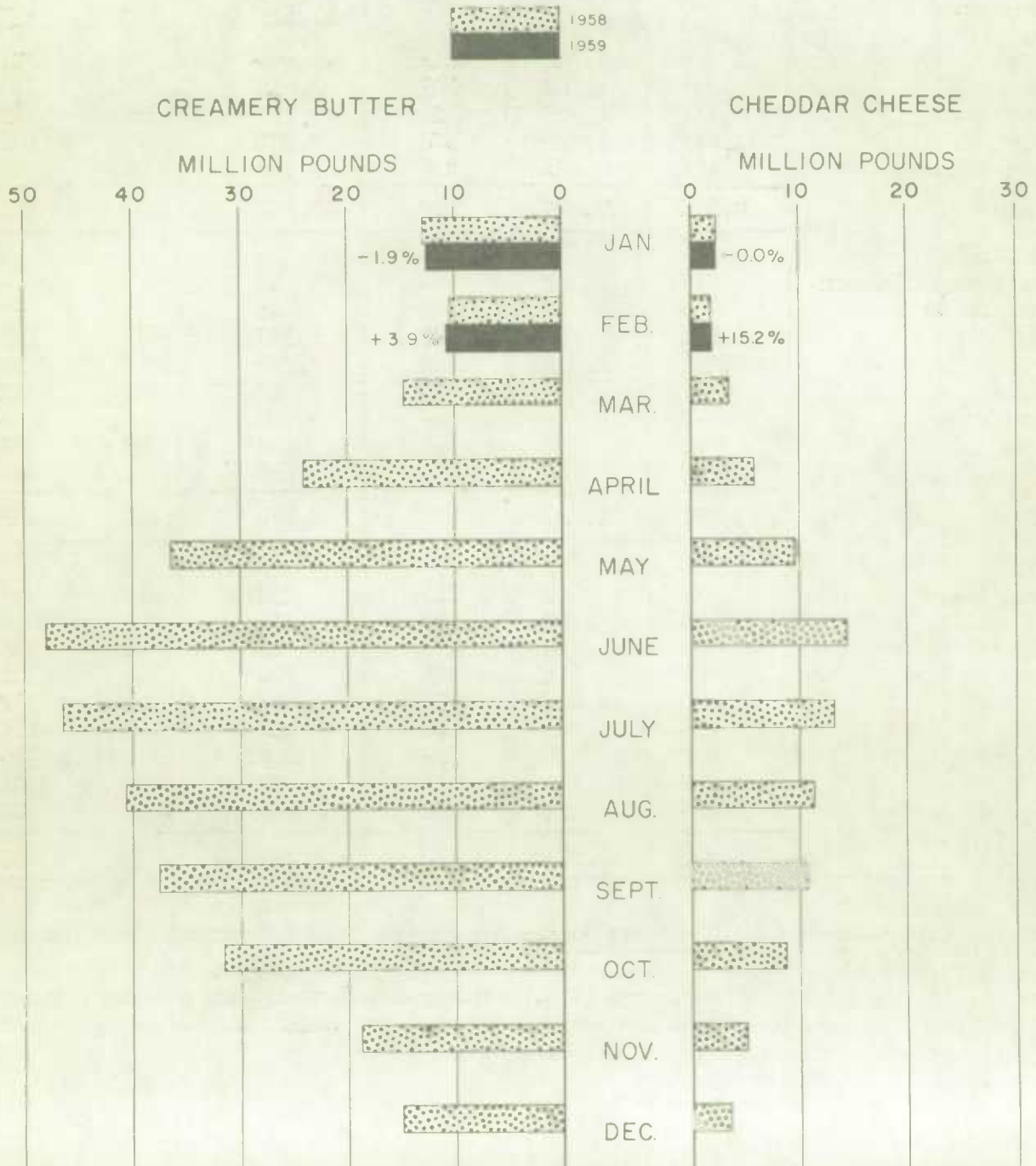

The Domestic Disappearance of Creamery Butter in Canada during February, according to preliminary production and stock data amounted to 22,155,000 pounds, 1.4 per cent more than the 21,839,000 pounds in February 1958. Cumulative January and February disappearance of creamery butter, at 46,166,000 pounds was 0.4 per cent less than the 46,368,000 pounds in the corresponding period of 1958.
