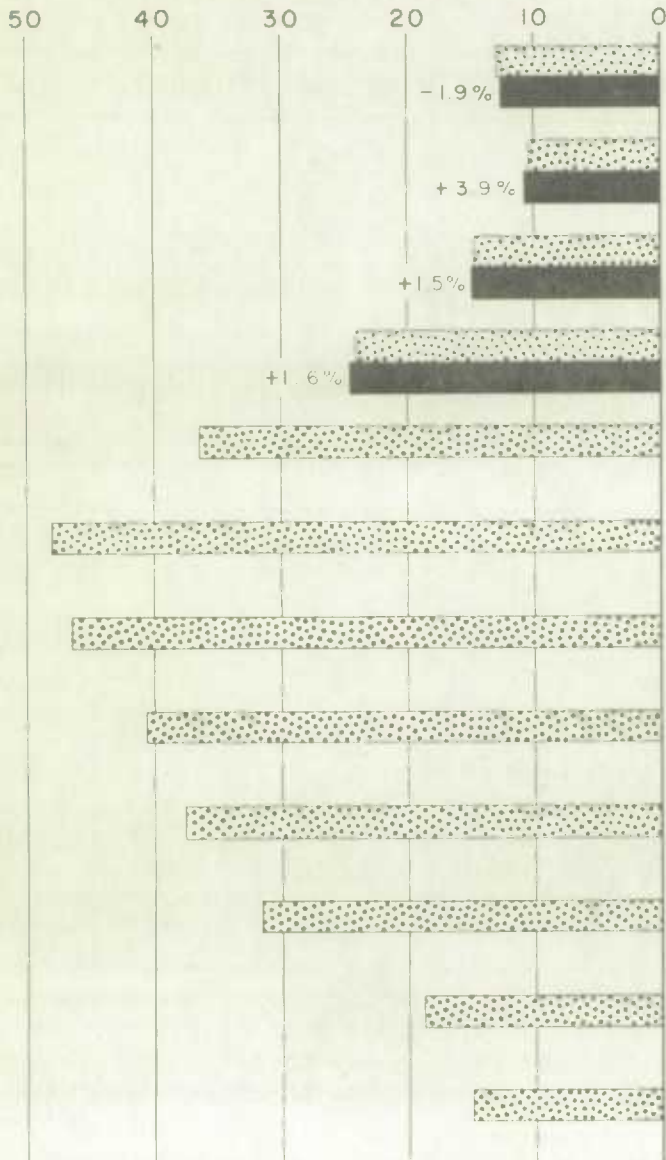

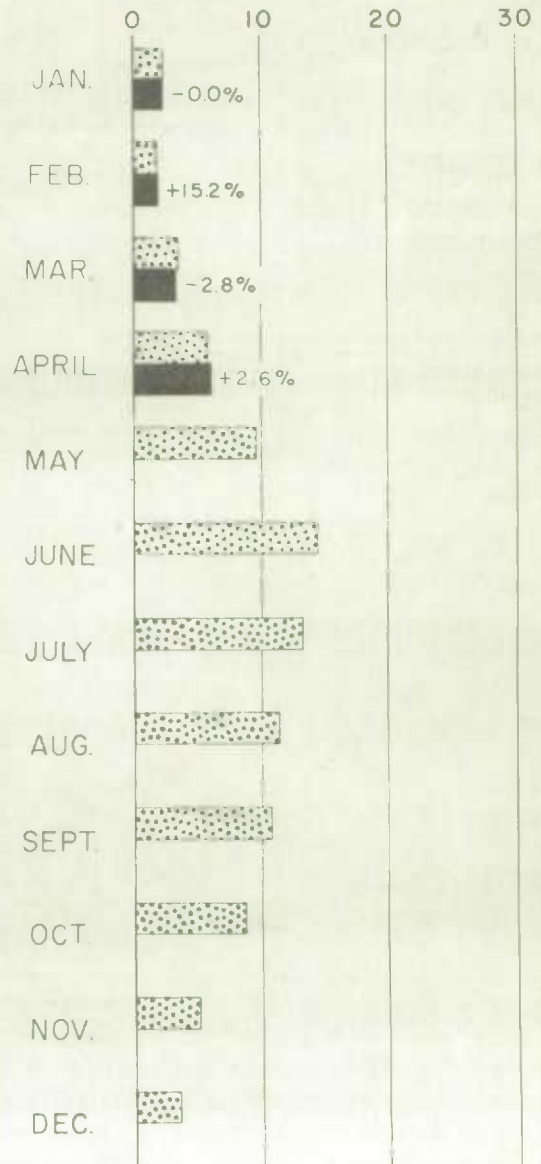

The Domestic Disappearance of Creamery Butter in Canada during April, according to preliminary production and stock data, amounted to 23,710,000 pounds, 7.9 per cent less than the 25,748,000 pounds in April, 1958. Cumulative January to April disappearance of creamery butter, at 93,878,000 pounds was 2.5 per cent less than the 96,310,000 pounds in the corresponding period of 1958.
