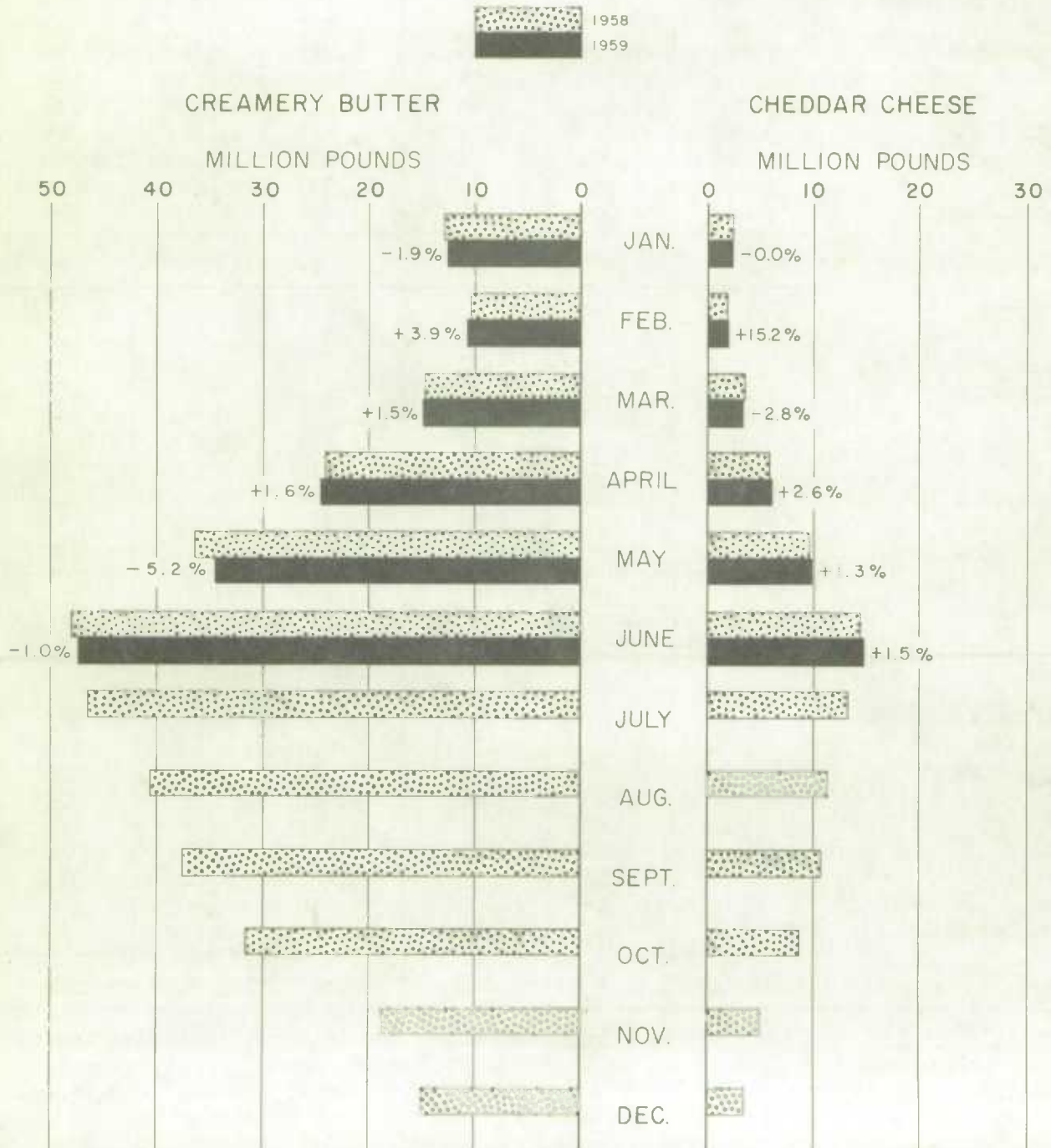

The Domestic Disappearance of Creamery Butter in Canada during June, according to preliminary production and stock data, amounted to 25,869,000 pounds, 1.7 per cent more than the 25,442,000 pounds in June, 1958. Cumulative January to June disappearance of creamery butter, at 144,920,000 pounds was 2.4 per cent less than the 148,552,000 pounds in the corresponding period of 1958.
