The Domestic Disappearance of Creamery Butter in Canada during July, according to preliminary production and stock data, amounted to 23,995,000 pounds,12.0 per cent less than the 27,259,000 pounds in July, 1958. Cumulative January to July disappearance of creamery butter, at 169,209,000 pounds was 3.8 per cent less than the 175,811,000 pounds in the corresponding period of 1958.
