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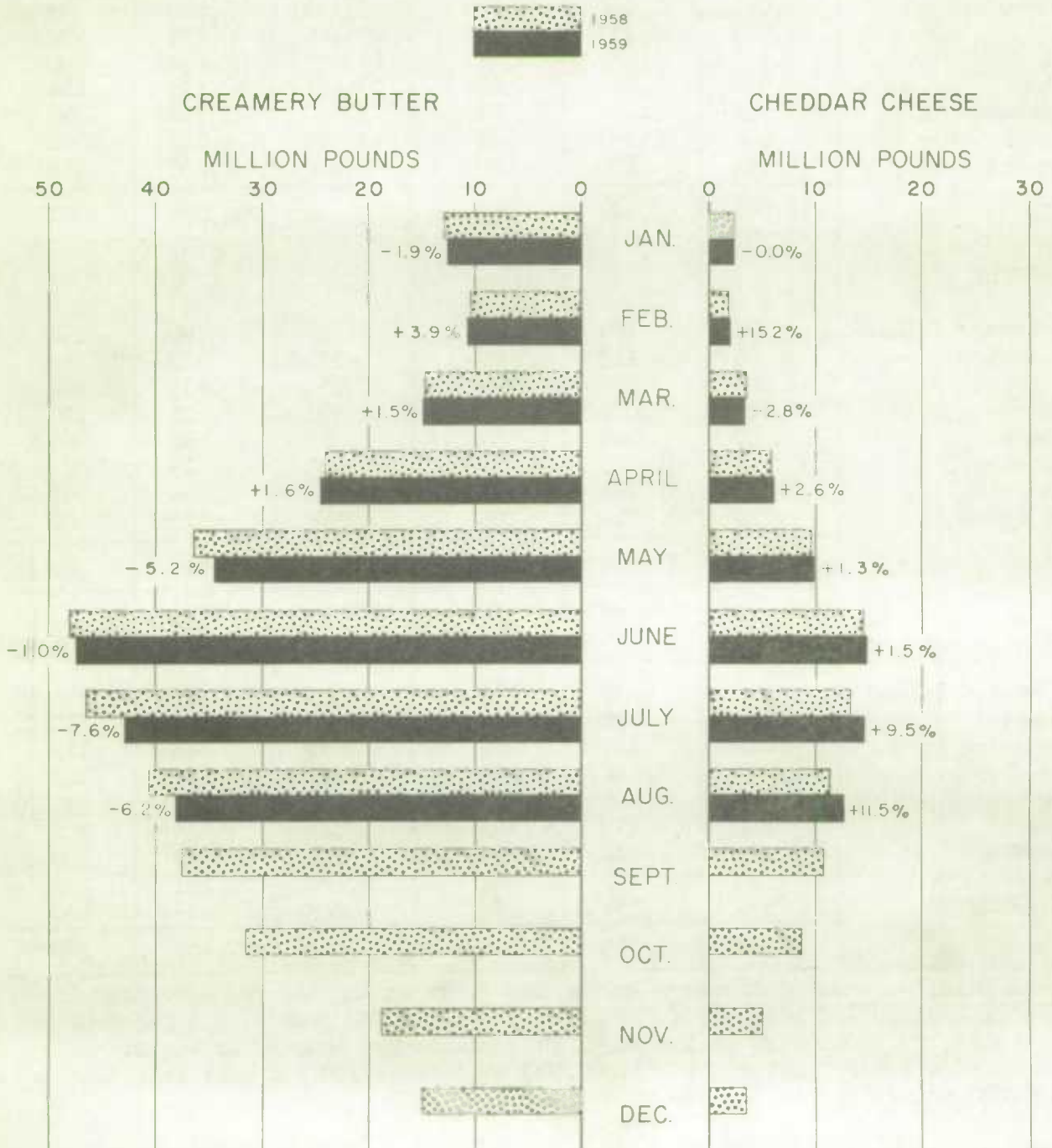

The Domestic Disappearance of Creamery Butter in Canada during August, according to preliminary production and stock data, amounted to 25,409,000 pounds, 0.5 per cent more than the 25,289,000 pounds in August, 1958. Cumulative January to August disappearance of creamery butter, at 195,060,000 pounds was 3.0 per cent less than the 201,100,000 pounds in the corresponding period of 1958.
